Notification

Sub: Inviting Applications from private candidates for the Vidwat-Madhyama (B.A.) & Vidwat-Uttama (M.A.) Examinations

Applications are being hereby invited from private candidates who wish to appear for **Vidwat-Madhyama (B.A.) & Vidwat-Uttama (M.A.) Examinations for the year 2014-15**. Private candidates should submit the application form directly to the office of Karnataka Samskrit University (Except private candidates who are repeaters). Private candidates who are applying fresh should not submit the application form through the colleges.

Rules governing admission of private candidates

B.A. (Sanskrita Vidwan-Madhyama)

Period of Syllabus: 3 Years

Eligibility for admission

1. Pass in all the subjects of Samskrit Sahitya Examination, or
2. Pass in Samskrit Prak-Shastri/Prak-Shiromani/ Uttara Madhyama/ Madhyama/Upashastri or other equal examinations conducted by certified examination boards. or
3. Pass in II P.U.C. / Inter-mediate/ 12th Class with Sanskrit as one of the subjects, or pass in Sanskrit Diploma/ Samskrita Kovidha/ Samskrita Dviteeya Deeksha/ Samskruta Vichakshana/ Agama Praveena of any University. or
4. Graduation from any university with Sanskrit as one of the languages. or
5. Post-Graduation in Sanskrit from any university. or
6. Pass in Kannada Pandit Madhyama Examination which is B.A. integrated. or
7. Pass in II P.U.C. / Inter-mediate/ 12th Class with Sanskrit together with clearance in entrance examination conducted by KSU.

M.A. Samskruta (Vidwat-Uttama)

Period of Syllabus: 2 Years

Eligibility for admission

1. Pass in B.A. Samskrita Vidwan-Madhyama in the respective Shastra/Veda or any other equivalent examination. or
2. Graduation with Sanskrit as one of the languages and Post-Graduation in Sanskrit, or Pass in in B.A. Samskrita Vidwan-Madhyama in the other Shastra/Veda or any other equivalent examination, can get admission into any other Shastra by completing the entrance examination.

3. Pass in M.A. Samskrita Vidwan-Uttama in the other Shastra/Veda or any other equivalent examination, can get admission into any other Shastra.

Eligibility for admission in Veda Subject

B.A. (Veda Vidwan-Madhyama)

1. Pass in Veda-Moola Examination.
2. Pass in P.U.C. with Sanskrit as a language and interest in Veda-Moola, in this connection, should be certified for having studied Veda by Veda Pathashalas or by traditional Veda scholars.
3. Pass in Samskrita Sahitya Exam or its equivalent and interest in Veda-Moola, in this connection, should be certified for having studied Veda by Veda Pathashalas or by traditional Veda scholars.
4. Pass in Veda-Moola examination or its equivalent in centers of national repute and accreditation.

M.A. (Veda Vidwan-Uttama)

1. Pass in Veda Vidwan-Madhyama or equivalent examination with Sanskrit as a language with study of Veda-Moola.
2. Graduation with Sanskrit as one of the languages and Post-Graduation in Sanskrit, or Pass in in B.A. Samskrita Vidwan-Madhyama in the other Shastra/Veda or any other equivalent examination with Kramanta Veda Adhyayana with certificate from centers of national repute and accreditation.

Note: certification of the respective Veda is necessary to gain admission into respective Veda course.

I. Internal Examination

1. Internal Examination for 20 Marks in Shastra and Veda Vidwan-Uttama Examination.
2. Private candidates should submit application form with name in respective subjects along with a 10-page essay with name and application form number, on the respective subject directly to the examination section of the KSU. In case of delay, the internal marks shall not be considered.

II Annual Examination

1. Max. 100 Marks Examination shall be conducted for Shastra subjects. Minimum marks required for pass is 35 in each subject.
 - i. 35-49: Pass
 - ii. 50-59: Second Class
 - iii. 60-79: First Class
 - iv. 80-100: Distinction
2. Carry-Over System for individual papers uncleared shall be continued to the next year for clearance.
3. Course Limit for Vidwan-Madhyama is 6 years. Students should have cleared all papers by this period. Course Limit for Vidwan-Uttama is 4 years. Students should have cleared all papers by this period

4. Clearing of examinations with backlogs' clearance shall not be considered for Class.
5. Minimum Age for private candidates appearing for Vidwan-Madhyama Ist Year should be 17 years as on 05-10-2014. Private candidates should appear consecutively for all the three years of examination.
6. Minimum Age for private candidates appearing for Vidwan-Uttama Ist Year should be 20 years as on 05-10-2014. Private candidates should appear consecutively for all the two years of examination.
7. If the Transfer Certificate is from another State, it has to be attested and certified by the Educational Officer of the respective state. Immigration Certificate should be procured.
8. In case of change of syllabus, the papers of changed syllabus need to be answered.
9. Private Candidates should not be regular candidates in any department in any Sanskrit College of that term.
10. Max. 100 Marks Examination shall be conducted for Shastra subjects.
Minimum marks required for pass is 40 in each subject.
 - v. 40-49: Pass
 - vi. 50-59: Second Class
 - vii. 60-69: First Class
 - viii. 70-100: Distinction

Note: Candidates who have passed in Vidwat Uttama/Veda or its equal in any subject can apply directly with attested relevant documents without entrance examination.

Details of Common Entrance Examination

B.A. Vidwat-Madhyama

50 Marks – Knowledge of Syllabus of Samskrita Sahitya

50 Marks – Knowledge of Nyaya & Vyakarana Syllabus of Samskrita Sahitya

M.A. Vidwat-Uttama

50 Marks – Knowledge of Samskrita Shastra Subjects (Objective Questions)

50 Marks – Descriptive-type examination in respective Shastra

Details of Examination Fee

1. Exemption in Examination Fee has been given to students belonging to SC/ST and Category I. Copy of Caste Certificate issued by Tahsildar duly attested has to be submitted. Applications shall be rejected without any notice in case of absence of copy of Caste Certificate.
2. The last date for submission of Application is 06-10-2014. Fee in the form of D.D. in favour of Finance Officer, Karnataka Samskrit Vishwavidyalaya, Chamarajpete, Bangalore-18 has to be submitted.
3. Applications after the last date shall be rejected. No correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.

5. For Candidates who have failed in the 2013/2014 Examination, the Examination Fee is Rs. 200 per paper.

6. Entrance Examination is only of the admission to I year. There shall be no Entrance Examination for II and III year.

7. Registration Fee is Compulsory.
