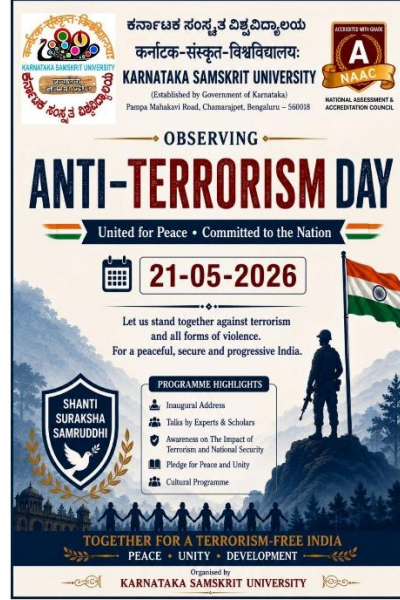


REPORT ON OBSERVATION OF ANTI-TERRORISM DAY
