His works are renowned for their exquisite use of language and their deep engagement with themes of nature, love, and the divine. He lived during the 4th-5th centuries CE, and while exact details about his life remain unclear, his influence on literature and culture is undeniable. The following verse states the importance of his compositions.

कालिदासगिरां सारं कालिदासस्वरस्वती।
चतुर्मुखोऽथवा साक्षाद्विदुर्नान्ये तु मादृशाः॥

By this Seminar it is aimed to emphasize the places mentioned in 2 Majakavyas (Raghuvamsha & Kumarasambhava) of the great poet Kalidasa with Geographical and Historical Identification of such places with Contemporary nomenclature and Values.
