- 7) Good academic record as defined by the concerned University with at least 55% of the marks (50% marks in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST) or equivalent grade wherever grading system is practiced at the Master's degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- 8) Besides fulfilling the above qualification, the candidate should have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar tests accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- 9) Holders of Ph.D. degree as on the date of Notification of UGC Regulations, along with those candidates who are awarded a Ph.D. degree through a process of admission, registration, course work and external evaluation as laid down in the UGC (Minimum Standards and procedures for award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Regulations, 2022 and so adopted by the university, shall be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.
- 10) Distinguished and eminent candidates having acquired high repute for propagation and disseminating the Sanskrit knowledge.
- 11) Outside of Karnataka candidates are not eligible for SC/ST/OBC reserved posts. They should apply against GM category.
- 12) Karnataka Public Employment (Reservation in Appointment for Hyderabad-Karnataka Region) (Organization of Local Cadres, Allotment and Transfer of Persons) Rules, 2013 is applicable.

Notes:

13. The Candidates who apply for the post of Guest Lecturer in the particular faculty shall have the Master's Degree and/ or Ph.D. in corresponding subject.
14. Qualification and other eligibility conditions are as per UGC Regulations 2018 published in the Official Gazette of India dated 18th July 2018 and the Statutes governing THE STATUTES RELATING TO APPOINTMENT AND PROMOTION OF TEACHERS AND OTHER ACADEMIC STAFF AND MEASURES FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF

STANDARDS IN HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE KARNATAKA SANSKRIT UNIVERSITY,
