The syllabus of the entrance test shall consists of 50% research methodology and 50% shall be subject oriented. The Entrance test would be conducted at the Karnataka samskrit university Campus only. The students qualified in the entrance test have to attend before interview committee for final selection. Medium: Sanskrit only (for Thesis writing also).

VIDYAVARIDHI (Doctor of Philosophy)

VIDYAVARIDHI (Doctor of Philosophy) is offered in the following Subjects / Areas. – Nyaya & vaisheshika, Vyakarana, Advaita vedanta, Vishistadvaita Vedanta, Dwaita Vedanta, Shakti – vishishtadvaita vedanta, Sankya and yoga, Dharmashastra, Veda, Sahitya and Inter- disciplinary subjects.

The Karnataka Samskrit University, Bengaluru will award the degree of Vidyavaridhi to the students admitted as per rules, after completion of their research work duly evaluated by the examiners appointed by the University. The Sanskrit version of the degree will bear the name Vidyavaridhi and the corresponding version of the degree will be DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY.

Procedure of selection for VIDYAVARIDHI (Doctor of Philosophy)

As per the UGC regulation 2016 Entrance test will be conducted for 100 marks. The minimum qualifying marks of the test would be 50%. The syllabus of the entrance test shall consists of 50% research methodology and 50% shall be subject oriented. The Entrance test would be conducted at the Karnataka Samskrit university Campus only. The students qualified in the entrance test have to attend before interview committee for final selection. Medium: Sanskrit only (for Thesis writing also).

(Seat allocation will be as per the state govt. reservation policy and orders issued by the state govt. time to time)

Vidyavachaspati (D.Litt)

Any Masters Degree holders of Karnataka Samskrit University or of any other University equivalent thereto, provided the candidate has obtained his / her Master's degree in M.A in Sanskrit with a specialization in any one of the disciplines at least 10 years prior to submission of application.

OR

Any person who has contributed to the development of any field of Sanskrit Shastras or inter disciplinary field related to Sanskrit with not less than 20 years.

a. Candidates who apply for consideration for the award of the degree shall submit copies of the published work(s) / collection of research papers / book (s)/thesis.12 copies of the synopsis of each book / thesis / work/work(s) and/or 12 copies of abstract of the research papers at the time of submitting the application.

- b. Such an application shall be accompanied by declaration duly signed by the candidate to the effect that such thesis / book / book(s) / work(s) are original and that it has not / they have not previously formed the basis for award of any degree/diploma or any other similar title of any University.
- The candidate must also send the DD for the Fee amount prescribed by the University for the Degree along with the application. However, scholar invited by the university is exempted from the fees.
- Fees will be decided by the university and announced thereon.

LIBRARY

The Library began its journey with the establishment of Sri Chamarajendra Samskrit College in 19th century which was greatly patronized by His Highness, Sri Jayachamarajendra Wodeyar, the then King of Mysore. The mission of the University Library is to preserve and maintain ancient manuscripts that have significant scientific, historical or aesthetic value and to acquire, organize and disseminate new knowledge based information resources pertaining to Sanskrit language including books, manuscripts, thesis and journals, to satisfy the information needs of the academic fraternity. At present, the library has the great stock of 8000 rare books on Vedas, Upanishads, Dharmashastra, Puranas and Mahakavyas (literature) written in Sanskrit language. Apart from rare books, the library is equipped with 2300 books written in Samskrit, Kannada and English language. The library also houses many manuscripts which are written in a number of different scripts like Telugu script, Grantha script, Devanagari script, Halegannada script, available on different disciplines like Shastra, Vyakarana, Puranas, Veda studies etc. The library has adopted Koha library management software to carry out library activities and all the books have been bar-coded.
