RESEARCH PROGRAMMES

VIDYAVARIDHI (Doctor of Philosophy)

VIDYAVARIDHI (Doctor of Philosophy) is offered in the following Subjects / Areas. – *Nyaya & Vaisheshika, Vyakarana, Advaita Vedanta, Vishistadvaita Vedanta, Dwaita Vedanta, Shakti – Vishishtadvaita Vedanta, Sankya and Yoga, Dharmashastra, Veda, Sahitya and Inter- disciplinary subjects.*

The Karnataka Samskrit University, Bengaluru will award the degree of Vidyavaridhi to the students admitted as per rules, after completion of their research work duly evaluated by the examiners appointed by the University.

The Samskrit version of the degree will bear the name Vidyavaridhi and the corresponding version of the degree will be DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY.

Procedure of selection for VIDYAVARIDHI (Doctor of Philosophy)

As per the UGC regulation 2018 and KSU Rules an Entrance test will be conducted for 100 marks. The minimum qualifying marks of the test would be 50%. The syllabus of the entrance test shall consist of 50% research methodology and 50% shall be subject concerned. The Entrance test would be conducted at the Karnataka Samskrit University Campus only. The students qualified in the entrance test have to appear before the interview committee for final selection.

Medium: Samskrit only (for Thesis writing also).

(Seat allocation will be as per the state govt. reservation policy and orders issued by the state govt. from time to time)

Vidyavachaspati (D.Litt)

Any Master's Degree holders of Karnataka Samskrit University or of any other University

Equivalent thereto, provided the candidate has obtained his / her Master's degree in M.A in Samskrit with specialization in any one of the disciplines at least 10 years prior to submission of application.

OR

Any person who has contributed to the development of any field of Samskrit Shastras or Interdisciplinary field related to Samskrit with not less than 20 years.

- a. Candidates who apply for consideration for the award of the degree shall submit copies of the published work(s) / collection of research papers / book (s)/thesis.12 copies of the synopsis of each book / thesis/ work/work(s) and/or 12 copies of abstract of the research papers at the time of submitting the application.
- b. Such an application shall be accompanied by declaration duly signed by the candidate to the effect that such thesis / book / book(s) / work(s) are original and that it has not / they have not previously formed the basis for award of any degree/diploma or any other similar title of any University.
- c. The candidate must also send the DD for the Fee amount prescribed by the University for the Degree along with the application. However, scholar invited by the university is exempted from the fees.
- d. Fees are published in the University website.

❖ Department of Alankara:

Alankara shastra deals with various theories like Alankara, Rasa, Reeti, Dhvani, Guna, Vakrokti, Auchitya etc. Detail study of these theories are of utmost importance to understand the Indian literary criticism and Indian poetics. Poetry was mostly governed by the Alankaras, the rules of critical science. Critics believed that any association of word and memory having a special quality generates kavya. The creation of mnemonic rhymes was considered essential to poetry. Poetry was considered as having two qualities: Alankara and Guna or "meaning" and "essence." There is an unbroken line of literary theory and criticism in Indian culture that goes back at least as far as the Western tradition. Indian criticism constitutes an important and largely untapped resource for literary theorists, as the Indian tradition in important respects assigns a more central role to literature than the Greek tradition does. Literary criticism in India resulted from the historical developments in poetry and drama.

CENTRAL LIBRARY

The central library began its journey with the establishment of Sri Chamarajendra Samskrit College in 19th century which was greatly patronized by His Highness, Sri Jayachamarajendra Wodeyar, the then King of Mysore. The mission of the University Central Library is to preserve and maintain ancient manuscripts that have significant scientific, historical or aesthetic value and to acquire, organize and disseminate new knowledge based information resources pertaining to Samskrit language including books, manuscripts, thesis and journals, to satisfy the information needs of the academic fraternity. At present, the Central library has great stock of 8000 rare books on Vedas, Upanishads, Dharmashastra, Puranas and Mahakavyas (literature) written in Samskrit language. Apart from rare books, the library is equipped with 2300 books written in different languages. The library also houses many manuscripts which are written in a number of different scripts like Telugu, Grantha, Devanagari script, Halegannada script, available on different disciplines like Shastra, Vyakarana, Puranas,

Veda studies etc. The Central library has adopted Koha library management software to carry out library activities.

ACADEMY OF SAMSKRIT RESEARCH, MELUKOTE

Melukote has been a holy shrine renowned for its history, tradition and rich heritage. Diverse Puranic accounts accord an epithet 'Jnanamantapa' (the abode of knowledge) to this place as great legacy of tradition, culture and Samskrit learning has been associated with it. A living vibrant temple tradition along with traditional learning ways is an integral part of its society. The harmonious social fabric brought about by Acharya Sri Bhagavat Ramanuja one thousand years ago which lives here even today has to be significantly remembered as his greatest contribution to the society considering present social conditions everywhere. Both his philosophical treatises as well as his social commitments bear the stamp of clarity, integrity and equanimity. His divinity, power and genuine social concern have been the invisible factor working positively for melukote even to this day.

Keeping in mind the special position of philosophy, school of thought, tradition, social values and the vision of Sri Bhagavad Ramanujacharya, Government of Karnataka established the Academy of Samskrit Research in Melukote in 1976.

The academy has completed four decades of meaningful existence in pursuit of excellence with financial grant coming from the Government of Karnataka. It has collected and preserved 10000 invaluable palm leaf manuscripts and 31000 books of immense value in the library. It has been constantly engaged in research and publication activity.

It has brought forth 166 publications till date. The list of publication includes critical editions, research works, and translations in Samskrit, Kannada and English.

Keeping in view further development of the academy, the state government on 15-12-2015 has brought it under the administrative and executive control of Karnataka Samskrit University, Bengaluru.
