The Rasa theory expounded by Bharata-muni in Nätyašistra forms the basis on which many artistic disciplines have evolved over the course of Indian history.

The course enables a complete textual reading of the Nätyašistra in its original, along with the relevant segments of the Abhinava-bharati, a commentary on the text by Abhinava-gupta. It provides a thorough understanding of the aesthetics of Indian classical art forms, thereby enabling the performing artists and connoisseurs to dive deeper into their respective forms of art.
