





The following has been agreed by the parties:

A) Purpose of Agreement

The PROJECT OWNER shall arrange for training of the Research Scholars appointed by the EXECUTION PARTNER in the specific methodology required to enable the ShAstramapping of selected parts of the aforementioned texts. The PROJECT OWNER agrees to allocate required funds and resources for implementation of the project as agreed with the EXECUTION PARTNER, as specified in Clauses D and E.
