## Best Practices-1

### 1. Title of the Best Practice

#### **Preserving and Transferring Indian Traditional Knowledge for Future Generations**

The vision of Karnataka Samskrit University, Bengaluru is to preserve and transmit Indian Traditional Knowledge System to future generations. For the purpose, it has taken several initiatives to educate, prepare and train students in traditional shastric systems. Some of the programmes undertaken are as follows:

- Training students for Vakyartha
- Organizing Vakyartha Sabhas based on Shastra Granthas such as Vyakarana, Nyaya, Vedanta, Mimamsa etc.
- Training on Shastric texts to public as per Gurukula system
- Training for Shastric Kantha Patha

### 2. Objectives of the Practice

- a) Train and preserve the traditional methods of debate and scholarly engagement and interaction.
- b) Attract students and public to learn traditional texts and create awareness about the diversity and vast depth of Samskrit language and literature.
- c) Educate as well as enables continuation of traditional Shastra Parampara through competitions such as Shalaka, Vada-prativada, Vakyarthasparsha and so on.
- d) Identify talented students and encourage them with adequate support and guidance.
- e) Sruti system of knowledge preservation will be continued through Kantha Patha training.

### 3. The Context

One of the main aims of KSU is to preserve and protect traditional knowledge and its values. The Shastric way of learning is at risk of discontinuation in many states and

the university's programmes are geared to ensure that they are preserved and protected for future generations.

The Sruti system of ancient knowledge transfer has been passed on from one generation to another generation through traditional gurukulas. The university is striving hard to adapt this practice by training students and public through Kantha Pathas of Ashtadhyayi, Amarakosha etc.

#### 4. Practice:

- Rigorous training on elaborating the concepts in Shastric texts has been given to the regular students along with their syllabus.
- Kantha Patha of Ashtadhyayi, Amarakośa, lakāra, nominal forms has been added in the syllabus in undergraduate programmes for creating good foundation for higher studies.
- The departments conduct Vakhyartha Sabhas in various disciplines to give opportunities to students to practice the nuances of Shastric learning.
- Conduct online short-term programmes following Gurukula system for both students and general public to popularize ancient method of teaching and learning.
- University maintains a center for preservation and conservation of traditional knowledge by collecting and safeguarding the manuscripts.

#### 5. The evidence of Success:

The evidence of success is in the following factors:

- KSU has been instrumental for consistently being awarded Vijay Vaijayanti (a prestigious award given at the national level to the best state acquiring high points in Shastric competitions) for the last 10 years.
- Students of KSU from non-Sanskrit background have participated in Vakhyartha Sabhas along with traditional pundits.
- Students who have attended online Gurukula Svadhyaya enrolled into regular undergraduate and postgraduate programmes to acquire in-depth knowledge.
- Trained students have joined the university in various positions such as guest faculty, research associates.
- Trained students are voluntarily working in various multidisciplinary research and developing computational tools for general public.

## 6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required

There is a huge potential for multidisciplinary research to align ancient Indian Knowledge Systems to modern disciplines. However, KSU encounters the following problems.

- Lack of funds to expand the multidisciplinary research in diverse disciplines based on Samskrit texts such as management, medical practices, Rasayana shastra, Clinical Psychology, Environmental Sustainability, Agriculture etc.,
- Due to lack of awareness of public about the traditional way of learning the University had to put extra efforts to create awareness about the programmes and their scope.

### Resources required:

- Exclusive laboratories for conducting practical training for Manovijyana, Yoga, and other scientific disciplines.
- Need for traditionally trained people who are equally well versed with modern systems.



### Objectives of the Practice

There is a wide spread perception among general public that Samskrit represents only religious and spiritual content. The objective of the programme is to,

- Help students to become self-sufficient in spoken Samskrit language skills.
- Expose the diversity present in Samskrit language and literature and provide avenues for de-stressing and engaging in learning Samskrit kavyas and dramas.
- Attracting school and college students to pursue higher education in Samskrit through competitions.
- Providing opportunities to homemakers who have discontinued studies due to domestic commitments to study further and fulfill their unfulfilled ambitions.
- Coping with modern stressful lifestyles by teaching value-based Samskrit texts such Yoga, Counselling etc.

### 2. The Context
