- (b) Any degree with one among the following:
- i) Sahitya or Equivalent course
 - ii) Certificate/Diploma in Samskrit/Pali/Prakrt/Manuscriptology
 - iii) Kovida Exam by Samskrit Bharati
 - iv) Pravesha Exam by Saraswati Sabha, Sringeri

- v) Entrance Exam conducted by Karnataka Samskrit University
vi) Any other examination recognized by the State/National level Sanskrit University/ Institution as equivalent to Shastri.
