Sub: Inviting applications for Admission to Ph.DVidyavaridhi Course 2024-25.

Ref: Approval of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Para no.5 Dated 22.10.2024

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission to Ph.DProgramme offered by various departments of the university for the academic year 2024-25. The subjects are Sanskrit Language and Literature, Vedanta, Nyaya and Vaisheshika, Alankara, Manuscriptology, Vyakarana, Jyotisha, Veda and Interdisciplinary.

Filled application Form with prescribed fee and required documents of two sets shall be submitted on or before 16.11.2024. The candidates shall submit a hardcopy of the application to the **“Director, Research &P.G.Studies, Karnataka Samskrit University, Chamarajpete, Bengaluru-560018”**along with mandatory enclosures on or before 20.11.2024.

The application fee for GM and OBC candidates is Rs.750/- per subject.SC/ST/Cat-I candidates with annual income less than Rs. 2.5 Lakhs per annum is Rs.375/- per subject . (For students who produce Caste and Income certificate issued by the Concerned Authority of Karnataka Only.) Fees should be paid throughonline only (Online Payment-SBI Collect on the website www.ksu.ac.in)and a copy of the same shall be enclosed along with the application.

Candidates who have qualified in respective Master's degrees have to appear for the Entrance Test and those candidates who have qualified for UGC-NET/KSET/ SLET/CSIR- IRF /GATE Examinations are exempted from the Entrance Test, However, all such candidates have to appear for an interview along with the candidates who have qualified through the Entrance Test.

Incomplete applications or applications without supportive documents will be rejected. The candidates can contact the respective Adhyayananga, for more information.

1. Eligibility: Candidates who have secured at least 55% of aggregate marks (50% for SC/ST/CAT 1 candidates) or equivalent grade under grading system, in their Master's Degree or equivalent examination from the recognized Universities/institutions.
2. Applications submitted after the last date will not be considered and Fee once paid will not be refunded.

General Instructions:

- ❖ Full time Research scholars will be preferred.
- ❖ Those who are permanent employees in government and aided institutions shall submit NOC at the time of application.
- ❖ Part-Time: Those who are working in private institutions/ government/ aided institutions on a contract basis submit NOC at the time of application.

- ❖ Applications will be received by the Adhyayananga on all the working days between 10.30 A.M. to 5.30 P.M.
- ❖ Attested copies of all relevant documents should be enclosed.
- ❖ In case the candidates who claim reservation but fail to enclose the supporting documents, their candidature will be considered under general merit.
- ❖ Candidates who are in service should submit their application through proper channel.
- ❖ A Candidate who has cleared NET/SLET/KSET etc. can also apply for the entrance test and submit both application separately.
- ❖ Entrance Exam Admission Tickets may be collected from the Chairperson of the respective departments / Adhyayananga Karnataka Samskrit University University, Bengaluru in person.
- ❖ The University reserves the right to fill or not to fill the seats. .
- ❖ The University will not be responsible for any postal delay from the candidates.
- ❖ The Karnataka State reservation policy shall be applicable for the selection of the candidates.
- ❖ Students pursuing inter- disciplinary research shall have the mastery in both disciplinaries.
- ❖ All PhD fees are prescribed according to the University PhD fee norms and shall be notified from time to time.
- ❖ University shall notify the updates relating to the Ph.D. on its official website www.ksu.ac.in. Personal calls / E-mail/Letters will not be entertained.
- ❖ The Applicants should fill the Google Form compulsorily.


Note:

- ❖ The Entrance Test will consist of one paper for 100 marks. Part – A includes multiple choice questions for 50 Marks from various disciplines like Veda, Vyakarana, Nyaya, Vedanta, Jyotisha, Alankara, Sanskrit Language & Literature, Research Methodoly and Aptitude etc. Part – B shall consist of descriptive type questions for 50 marks from the subjects for which the applicant has applied. Interdisciplinary students shall also appear for this examination. The duration of the Test will be for 3 hours.

- ❖ A candidate securing a minimum of 50 marks out of 100 (45 marks out of 100 in case of SC/ST/CAI-1 candidates) in the Entrance Test shall be eligible for next stage of the Ph.D, programme.
- ❖ There shall be 30% weightage for the performance of the candidate in the interview and 70% weightage for entrance test.
- ❖ In the case of candidates who have passed UGC-CSIR/DBT/ICAR/JRF/SRF /GATE/ KSET the merit list will be prepared on the basis of 50% of marks secured in the interview and 50% marks in Master's Degree Examination. In case of candidates securing equal percentage of marks from both Master's Degree Examination and marks secured in the Interview, such candidates who have secured higher percentage in the Master's Degree Examination will be placed higher in ranking.
- ❖ The candidates eligible for exemption from the Entrance Test will be informed separately regarding the interview date, time and venue. Each detail shall be notified through the official University website.
- ❖ Vacant seats shall be allotted in a 50:50 ratio for candidates who had taken entrance exempted.
- ❖ Details of the vacant seats are provided in Annexure- I.
