Introduction

Karnataka Samskrit University (KSU) was established by the State Government of Karnataka in the year 2010 through the Karnataka Samskrita Vishwavidyalaya Act 2009 (KSV Act) passed by the Karnataka State Legislature. The university is currently recognized by the University Grants Commission under section 2F, has been accorded the 12(B) status of the UGC Act, 1956 and has been accredited with NAAC 'A' grade.

Karnataka Samskrit University has been formed exclusively for the development of Samskrit language. Samskrit has a hoary, glorious, scientific, literary, cultural tradition and heritage. Its contribution in the area of Prose, Poetry, Drama, Dance, Sculpture, Paintings, Fine arts, Medicines, Philosophy and other allied areas is far more extensive and lasting than has been realized by the Indian scholars till today.

One hundred acres of land has been allotted for the University in Kuduru, Hobli, Magadi Taluk, Ramanagar District, Karnataka. Construction of the new campus is completed on this land allotted by the Karnataka Government.

The University currently includes three constituent Samskrit Colleges, two constituent research centres, 11 aided affiliated colleges and 66 unaided affiliated colleges under its ambit. There are also 281 aided Veda and Samskrita Pathashalas spread over the State. The university has 495 students studying on the campus and around 30,000 students in affiliated colleges and other campuses. Till date, eleven convocations have been conducted where degrees have been awarded to students.

Directorate of Samskrit Education is separately established by the Government of Karnataka to administer the Samskrit pathashalas. The Karnataka Samskrit University was established in 2010 by the government of Karnataka with the vision and mission of bringing these together under a single umbrella, maintaining uniformity in education, providing greater opportunities for study for students and teachers and to raise the standards in Samskrit research at National and International level.

Karnataka Samskrit University has three wings. They are:

1. Teaching and Research Wing
2. Publication Wing
3. Administrative Wing
4. Examination Wing

Through which the university has to be dynamically active. The university will promote the activities related to Samskrit in Karnataka through these wings.

Objectives and Educational Activities

The Karnataka Samskrit University has the following objectives:

1. To function as a high-level teaching and research institution in Samskrit language, Literature and Vedic studies and Shastras such as Vyakarana, Samkhya, Yoga, Nyaya, Vaisheshika, Mimamsa, Vedanta, Baudha, Jaina, Dharma Shashtra and others and also supportive education.
2. To preserve, foster and promote the traditional system of learning in Vedic, Agamic and Cognate Literature, with special emphasis on unique features available in Karnataka.
3. To highlight the wisdom contained in the Vedic and other disciplines, and their reference to the modern world.
4. To facilitate and regulate advance study and research in the fields like
 1. Geeta based management science.
 2. Yoga based human Psychology.
 3. Eco-balance related health related traditional knowledge.
 4. Archaeology.
 5. Ancient Sciences.
 6. Agama Shastra.
 7. Ayurvedic Sciences.
 8. Humanities.
 9. Social Sciences.
 10. Performing arts.

11. Fine Arts and Communication.
12. Vedadhyayana and Vedabhashya Studies and any other Sciences that have developed in Samskrit.
5. To highlight the profoundness of the rational approach and the scientific temper presented in the Vedas and the Shastras in the context of pursuit of knowledge empowerment and realization of higher levels of consciousness.
6. To consolidate, revive and promote the Bharateeya Jnana Parampara as also to integrate the scientific thoughts contained in the Vedas and Samskrit Literature particularly in the disciplines of Agriculture, Astronomy, Biology, Chemistry, Humanities, Information Technology, Law and Jurisprudence, Management, Mathematics, Metallurgy, Meteorology, Physics, Social Sciences and Yoga with modern scientific and technological studies.
7. To bring out awareness about the authentic interpretations of the Vedas.
8. To create a network of Vedic, Samskrit Institutions, Educational and Research oriented Institutes having similar objectives with reciprocal arrangements and facilities for interaction with a view to fostering a synergy of efforts made by all such Universities and Institutions.
9. To create a body of literature in Modern Indian and foreign languages on the contents of Samskrit and the Vedas.
10. To translate/publish all the Vedas, Shastrik works and related texts, Bhashyas and Commentaries in Kannada and other languages.
11. To build-up audio, audio-visual records of Vedic Chanting and related traditional practices.
12. To take appropriate measures for promoting inter-disciplinary studies and research in the university and such other related activities congenial at university level.
13. To collect, preserve, critically edit and publish rare manuscripts and ancient works by establishing an Oriental Research Institute in Samskrit.
14. To computerize and digitize the entire corpus of manuscripts and Samskrit texts.

15. To bring out Research journals of high standard through the University/Departments.
16. To organize seminars, conferences, workshops, Vidvath Goshties with a view to promoting awareness about the messages contained in ancient knowledge systems.
17. To admit educational institutions not maintained by the university to the privileges of the University as affiliated colleges/mahapathashalas/pathashalas in Karnataka.
18. To provide through its professors, teachers and the Department; a special research institutes such teaching and guidance as the affiliated colleges/mahapathashalas/pathashalas may require.
19. To undertake any other activities connected with or incidental to above objectives of the University.
20. To recognise and maintain for any purpose, either in whole or part, any institution on such terms and conditions as may vary from time to time be prescribed by Statutes and to withdraw such recognition.
21. To do such acts and other things, whether incidental to the power of aforesaid or not, as may be required in order to promote the objectives of the university.
22. To maintain such bodies as are by statutes declared to be the authorities of the University.
23. To establish 'Chairs' in various disciplines for conducting advanced research.

Vision and Mission

The University is trying to achieve the above objectives through the following educational activities

1. Strengthening Samskrit pathashalas and colleges, and creating the required facilities.
2. Encouraging students through scholarships.
3. Developing good library facilities in pathashalas and colleges.
4. Developing good hostel facilities in colleges, and providing food-lodging facilities to students with joint effort of the government and local patrons.

5. Encouraging students to organise and participate in Samskritotsavas and Samskrit competitions in each Taluk and district.
6. Identifying outstanding students in BA-Samskrit, MA-Samskrit and Vedic studies every year. Encouraging them through certificates and cash-prizes with the help of endowments, trusts and public funds.
7. Providing special facilities for Samskrit students of scheduled caste, scheduled tribes and other backward classes.
8. Conducting competitions in Samskrit singing, gamaka, and samskrit-sports.
9. Introducing compulsory English and Computer papers at Kaavya, Saahitya and Vidvat exams, and formulating appropriate syllabi for the same.
10. Scientifically revising the syllabus from Prathamaa to Vidvat levels. Ensuring that the texts focus equally on ancient and modern knowledge systems.
11. Creating higher learning centres for Samskrit in North Karnataka, Hyderabad Karnataka, Uttara Kannada, Dakshina Kannada and Central Karnataka. Providing an environment conducive to higher study and research in these centers. Undertaking collaborations with local Samskrit learning bodies.
12. Introducing special package programmes for all pathashalas older than 50 years, and develop infrastructure in these pathashalas
13. Providing equal recognition and opportunities to Vidvat-scholars, as those available to BA and MA degree holders.

Vision for Future

To become a world-class university with a focus on preservation and promotion of Samskrit language and literature through quality education and research using ancient wisdom and modern outlook. The main objectives of Karnataka Samskrit University for the future are:

- i. Function as a high-level teaching and research organization in Samskrit language, literature, Vedic studies and Shastras such as Vyakarana, Samkhya, Yoga, Nyaya, Vaisheshika, Mimamsa, Vedanta, Buddha, Jaina, Dharma Shastra.
- ii. Promote the study and use of Samskrit language in the state. Preserve, foster and promote the traditional system of learning in Vedic, Agamic, and Cognate literature with special emphasis on unique features available in Karnataka.

iii. Consolidate, revive and promote the Bharateeya Jnana Parampara and bridge the gap between the scientific thoughts contained in the Vedas and Samskrit Literature and modern science - particularly in the disciplines of Agriculture, Astronomy, Biology, Chemistry, Humanities, Information Technology, law and Jurisprudence, Management, Mathematics, Metallurgy, Meteorology, Physics, Social Sciences and Yoga with modern scientific and technological studies.

iv. Collect, preserve, critically edit and publish rare manuscripts and ancient works by establishing an Oriental Research Institute in Samskrit and computerize and digitize the entire corpus of manuscripts and Sanskrit texts.

v. Create a network of research-oriented Vedic and Samskrit institutions having similar objectives through reciprocal arrangements with a view to fostering a synergy of efforts.

vi. Facilitate and regulate advanced study and research fields such as,

- Bhagwat Geeta based management science
- Yoga-based human Psychology
- The relevance of traditional knowledge in domains such as ecology, medicine, archaeology, astronomy, science and technology to the modern world.

Universitiy Emblem & Motto.



The emblem of Karnataka Samskrit University was created by a famous artist of Karnataka, Sri. Muralidhara V Rathod. The logo, as conceptualized by the honourable Vice Chancellor and the artist, is unique. It contains the title of the university in Devanagari, English and Kannada scripts. Devanagari script has been chosen since the university is established for the promotion of Samskrit language, literature and knowledge. Devanagari has been extensively used since ancient times for representing many Indian languages. Through Devanagari script, the University symbolises the greatness of the divine language, Samskrit. The expanse and global reach of the university is signified by the English script. The university is the dream-child of the Karnataka government. It is a representative of all Samskrit scholars of Karnataka, and also intends to nurture mutual co-operation between Samskrit and Kannada languages. This is signified by the use of Kannada script in the logo.

The bird used in the logo is Peacock, the National bird. The peacock represents beauty and creativity. The vast expanse of knowledge which will be nurtured by the university is symbolically represented by this peacock. It emphasizes the vision that human life should be entwined inseparably with knowledge.

Motto for the university has been chosen from Mahabharata of Vedavyasa. The motto has been represented in Devanagari script in the logo. 'prajvālito jñānamayah pradīpah' indicates the supremacy of knowledge. This motto represents the objective of the university to unite ancient and modern knowledge systems. The lamp of knowledge should light up this world, going beyond place and time – this is the objective. This lamp will never be extinguished. It is not fueled by oil, but by knowledge itself, and will continue to burn forever. The logo and motto of the university represent this dream, with which the university has been set up.

Infrastructure

- Administrative Building:** The KSU has a two storeyed building for administrative needs.
- Academic Building:** A three storeyed building is being utilized only for teaching and research. The KSU has a separate Seminar Hall.

3. **Library Building:** The library is accommodated in Sri Chamarajendra College building with the special arrangement for preservation of manuscripts and books.
4. **Transit Hostel/Guest House:** The KSU has a two-storeyed transit hostel/guest house.
5. **Hostels:** The KSU has one hostel on its Bangalore campus and another in Mysore campus.
6. **Playground:** KSU main campus is situated in the heart of city and the Institutional area, with lots of play area and open space.
7. **ICT Resource Center:** The KSU has established “Information and Communication Technology Resource Centre” with sufficient Computer systems in Academic Building.
8. **Alternative power system:** Keeping in view the frequent Power fluctuations/ breakdowns, KSU has established an alternative power system (UPS) with 5 KVA.
9. **Drinking water:** The KSU has provided pure drinking water to the students and faculty.
10. **University Health center:** Primary health center functions in the new building with necessary facilities
11. **Study Centre:** The university has established a study centre titled “Bh. Mahaveer and Bh. Buddha Centre for Prakrt and Pali studies” supported by Minority Welfare Department, Government of Karnataka.

- vi. No age cap for joining the courses at the institution. Anybody with the zeal to learn samskrit is welcome irrespective of caste, creed, region, and religion.

- vii. Academy of Samskrit Research, Melkote is the constituent research center of the university and it works towards bringing out new outcomes in the field of Samskrit research.
- viii. Affiliated prominent research centers, colleges, yoga centers, astrology study centers are giving it a wider base.
- ix. Evening college is imparting Samskrit education among the public.
- x. Since the university is in the heart of the city, it is easily accessible and provides a golden ample opportunity for Samskrit enthusiast to learn Samskrit.

5. Sambhasha - An online learning Platform for Sanskrit

सं-भाषा

Karnataka Sanskrit University is developing various tools for learning, teaching, and analysing Sanskrit and other Bharatiya languages. These tools are hosted on its portal called **सं-भाषा** (<http://sambhasha.ksu.ac.in/>) – **सञ्ज्ञानकभाषा**. It is a web portal that hosts computational tools for Sanskrit and other Bharatiya languages developed for the benefit of public.

Provided as a non-profit service by Karnataka Sanskrit University, these tools are beneficial to a diverse group of individuals that include children, research scholars, students of Shastric studies Ayurvedic doctors and anyone with an interest in traditional knowledge systems. The aim of these projects and tools is to bridge the gap between the ancient Indian Knowledge Systems and its seekers. The tools are not limited to Sanskrit language but can be extended to all Bharatiya languages.

Karnataka Sanskrit University develops many language learning tools in collaboration with Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi. The University has many joint projects with Central Sanskrit University. Few of them are also listed out here.

This web portal serves as a valuable resource that can be categorized under the following heads:

Machine Translation and Natural Language Processing Tools:

Several tools have been developed under this head such as,

- Computational Tools for Pali, a tool based on Paninian rules - the module helps the reader to understand Pali texts and tap into the vast resources available in the language. The Pali Morphological generator/analyser and Sandhi Joiner/Splitter are also part of this tool and serves as a handy resource for students and research scholars studying Pali texts.
- Aayussamskritam Courseware for Ayurvedic Medical Students - A specially designed courseware and study kit based on the statistical study of Samskrit syntax employed in Ayurvedic texts. The course is particularly beneficial to Ayurvedic doctors and students who need to quickly gain knowledge of Samskrit language and research and gain inputs from the original Ayurvedic texts and reduce dependence on translations.

Language Learning Tools:

This segment aims to provide tools and exercises that enable students gain mastery of concepts in Samskrit language.

- Śabdakautukam Practice noun forms provides practice exercises for students to learn different noun forms. Vāñmayī-e is a web application tool envisaged to create an interface for students, teachers and enthusiasts to explore and understand the richness and vast repertoire of Sanskrit literature. With a pre-edited and curated text as raw input, the tool will analyse the text and provide information about the grammatical structure and elements essential to comprehend the text.

Tools for Shastric Studies:

Study of Shastras is universal across India. These tools help seekers to explore different shastras and understand subtle concepts that are contained in them through visual representation and mind mapping techniques and computational linguistics.

- Tarkasaṅgrahaḥ tool Ontological knowledge representation tool and Prācīnanyāyah Ontological knowledge representation tool enable to understand

complex concepts of Indian logic through visual representation and interactive elements.

- Anvayacitraṇam tool to draw relations between words in a sentence and understand its meaning. This is a concept that is universal to all Bharatiya languages and enables in comprehending complex sentences. The framework can be extended to other Bharatiya languages too.
- Bhaṭṭikāvya-nandinī allows users to explore Bhaṭṭikāvya with Karaka dependency diagram. The user-friendly interface makes learning easy and fun.
- Nāmadhātūrūpikā Denominative verbs enables students to access a nāmadhātu-vebal- form from the given prātipadika. Additionally, students also can analyses a Nāmadhā- tu-verbal-form and learn its morphological information.

Projects with universal applicability:

Under the aegis of **सं-भाषा**, Karnataka Samskrit University also handles different projects that are universal in nature and are applicable to wider audiences across the world.

Vaijayantīkośa Knowledge net: Vaijayantīkośa is an ancient Samskrit lexicon that has been widely quoted and referred to by ancient scholars. However, currently there are no known commentaries of the kośa and is currently not easily accessible to those who wish to benefit from this ancient repository of knowledge. The project aims to bring this knowledge to common people even if they have limited knowledge of Samskrit language.

Mahakośa project: The ongoing project aims at integrating all Samskrit kośas and make it searchable for online users. The project aims to integrate kośas such as Amarakośa, Vai- jayantīkośa, Halayudhakośa, Abhidanachintamani and so on.

Tools for young learners:

The Balashtadashi project, done in association with Central Samskrit University consists of 18 products for young learners that consists of interactive games, activities and educational content that enable children to focus and improve their memory.

All the above tools are in align with the ethos and theme of “Technology and Bharatiya Bhasa Summit”. We hope that these tools will also serve as an inspiration to other stakeholders too.

The library began its journey with the establishment of Sri Chamarajendra Samskrit College in 19th century which was greatly patronized by His Highness, Sri Jayachamarajendra Wodeyar, the then King of Mysore. The mission of the University Library is to preserve and maintain ancient manuscripts that have significant scientific, historical or aesthetic value and to acquire, organize and disseminate new knowledge based information resources pertaining to Samskrit Language including books, manuscripts, thesis and journals, to satisfy the information needs of the academic fraternity. At present, the library has the great stock of 8000 rare books on Vedas, Upanishads, Dharmashastra, Puranas and Mahakavyas (literature) written in Samskrit Language. Apart from rare books, the library is equipped with 2300 books written in Samskrit, Kannada and English language. The library also houses many manuscripts which are written in a number of different scripts like Telugu, Grantha, Devanagari, Halegannada script available on different disciplines like Shastra, Vyakarana, Puranas, Veda studies etc. The library has adopted Koha Library management software to carry out library activities and all the books have been bar-coded.
