Unaided Colleges - 19 <p>These colleges have been given user credentials to enter the data online and request for affiliation. Three new proposals received by the University for start new colleges. No 6 to the statute states that, The others and Notifications issued by the UGC and Government orders from time to time are deemed to be a part of the relevant sections of these statutes”.</p> <p>Further, Sl. No 7 to the statute states that “Any modifications and amendments that are going to be made by the Govt. of Karnataka from time to time shall be deemed to be an integral part of the original statute.”</p> <p>As per the approved statute relating to the promotion of teachers under Career Advancement Scheme in Karnataka Samskrit University (framed under section 38 (11) of Karnataka Samskrit University Act, 2009) and UGC Regulations 2018, the above subject is placed before the Syndicate for approval.</p>
